Called Together Diocesan Appeal Update

We are delighted to report that we're current at 72% of our diocesan goal, with 216,000 already received in support of our smaller parishes, ministries and missions throughout the diocese. Additionally, we currently have more than \$32,000 which will be sent as rebates to parishes that have met their portion of the diocesan goal.

This week, Sacred Heart Cathedral made a leap of more than 26% to reach almost 82%, Immaculate Conception Parish in Prince George jumped almost 25% to reach 63%, St. Patrick's in McBride added another 15% to reach almost 181%, and St. Andrew's in Fraser Lake added almost 9% to reach 113%. Other parishes also continued to make good progress, including Sacred Heart Parish in Terrace (61%), St. Mary's in Prince George (150%), Notre Dame in Dawson Creek (71%).

We still have 28% to go to meet the needs set out in this year's appeal and we ask for your continued support. Please continue to keep the many needs of our entire diocese in your prayers.

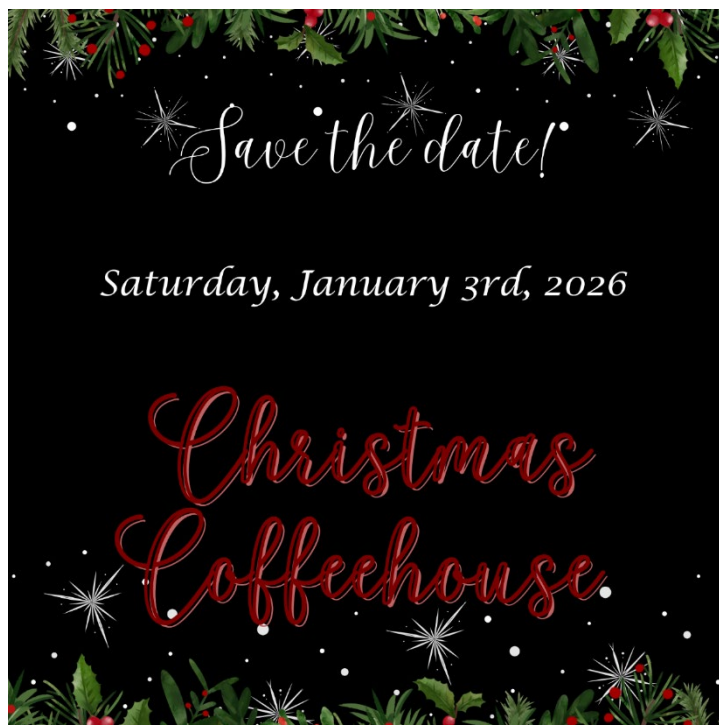
