Called Together Diocesan Appeal Update

We don't have too much to report since our last update. However, we're pleased to see that Sacred Heart Parish in Terrace made a huge leap of more than 34% to surpass their diocesan goal, reaching 128%. St. Mary's in New Hazelton climbed more than 8% to reach almost 150% of their diocesan goal. Christ the King in Kitimat hit 75% of their diocesan goal, rising 5%.

Thanks to everyone for your support financially and in prayer. We are in the process of distributing funds to appeal recipients and for parish rebates. The appeal continues until June 30th, and we still have 9.5% left to go in order to reach our diocesan goal.
