

Statement by the CCCB Permanent Council in support of Bill C-218

On February 4, 2026 The CCCB Permanent Council issued a public statement in support of Private Member's Bill C-218, which seeks to prevent persons whose sole condition is mental illness from accessing euthanasia ("MAiD"). Bill C-218 is expected to proceed to second reading in the House of Commons in early March 2026.

CFC - Singles for Christ Christian Life Program

CFC Singles for Christ (SFC) is a Catholic lay organization under the umbrella of Couples for Christ providing an environment for unmarried men and women from 18 to 40 years of age to grow in love and knowledge of God alongside other young Catholic adults on the same faith journey. As an evangelistic ministry, SFC aims not only to bring young adults to Christ, but to bring Christ to where they are - on campus, in the workplace, in the family, and in all walks of life.

SFC holds a Christian Life Program (CLP), the entry point into the community, in the spring and fall of each year. At its foundation, the CLP deals with three main concepts: our relationship with Jesus, how each of us responds to that call to relationship, and how we can make that relationship grow. During the course of the CLP, we put these concepts into a practical, real-world context, and discuss them in a way that relates to where we are now: out of school, embarking on our careers, and deciding what we are going to do with the rest of our lives.

At the conclusion of the Christian Life Program, we invite participants to continue their journey with the Singles for Christ community through weekly prayer meetings, assemblies, conferences, outreach opportunities, and fellowship with other like-minded young adults eager to grow in faith together. SFC encourages its membership to use their God-given talents and abilities in the service of the community at large, through leadership in the workplace and in the family and in active participation in the sacramental and ministry life of the Church.

We would like to extend an invitation to the young adults of the diocese to take that step – for the first time, or the first in a long time – to rediscover and develop the relationship to which our Father in heaven calls us. Our CLP is scheduled for the evening of April 10 through April 12, 2026, at the Emmaus House, Domano Renewal Centre.
